From start of the hand you always need to have a <u>plan of campaign</u> in your head

- Likely to change as the game develops

Opening lead is done and dummy comes down:

- Look to see if you have stopper in the suit led!!
- Count how many <u>top tricks</u> you have
- Then look at <u>safest way</u> to establish extra tricks needed

What does <u>Top Tricks</u> mean?

It means tricks that are <u>ready to cash</u>

With * K Q J 2 opposite * T 9 7, for example, you would have no top tricks in clubs.

 You have to knock defender's ace before you score any tricks in clubs
