You want to investigate possible SLAM

- 1M 3M invitational,
 - opener very strong
- 1M 3D Bergen = invitational and 4 card support
 - opener very strong
- 1M 3NT Bergen 13-15hcp 3 card support
- 1M 4x splinter good support and shortage in the suit bid
- 1M 2NT <u>Jacoby 2NT</u>, 4 card support and 13+hcp

Partner opens major; 1H or 1S

We bid <u>Jacoby 2NT</u>, telling partner that:

- We have 4 card support
- We have 13+ high card points
- We definitely have game
- Inviting partner to cooperate, investigating slam

Traditional opener responses to Jacoby 2NT

- Bid a new suit at 3 level → shows singleton or void in that suit
- Jump to 4 level in a new suit $\rightarrow 2^{nd} good 5 cards$ suit
- Bid agreed suit at 3 level → No shortage, Good hand (16+ total points)
- Bid game at agreed suit → No shortage and a minimum opening hand 13-15 TP

Jacoby 2NT – Tools to use

Cue Bidding to:

- Check for controls
- Identify which controls we have between us

To ensure we are not missing two controls in any suits

Use Key Card Blackwood to:

- How many Key cards we have
 - 4 Aces and King of trump (5 Key Cards)
 - Do we have queen of trump or not?

Combing both methods to decide if we bid slam or not?

Jacoby 2NT – Cue Bidding

American Approach:

- Showing 1st Round Control up the line:

aces or void

Italian Method:

- Showing 1st or 2nd Round Controls up the line:

aces or void, King or singleton

Slam Bidding – 1430 RKCB

In a Major suit contract, King of trump, same as aces, is a Key Card. So we have 5 Key Cards (4 aces and king of trump).

Also Queen of Trump is an important card

4NT after a Major fit is established asks for Key Cards. Responses:

- 5C = 1 or 4 Key Cards
- 5D = 0 or 3 Key Cards
- 5H = 2 Key Cards and no Queen of trumps
- 5S = 2 Key Cards plus queen of trump

Slam Bidding – 1430 RKCB

After 5C or 5D, next suit up asks for queen of trump. Responses:

- Return to trump suit = No queen of trump
- 5NT (or bidding slam) yes I have the Queen but no other King to show you
- Any other suit = Yes I have the Queen & this particular king

In response to 5NT we either show kings or bid grand slam with a source of tricks

Bidding a suit at 6 level says: If you have Queen of this particular suit, bid 7

Traditional opener responses to Jacoby 2NT

- Bid a new suit at 3 level → shows singleton or void in that suit
- Jump to 4 level in a new suit $\rightarrow 2^{nd} good 5 cards$ suit
- Bid agreed suit at 3 level → No shortage, Good hand
- Bid game at agreed suit → No shortage minimum opening hand

If partners are interested in slam, they will:

- Cue Bid to identify controls
- Use Key Card Blackwood to identify key cards

Based on identified information they decide to bid slam or not?

Alternative approach

Partners immediately start Cue Bidding (Italian approach) up the line:

- Showing 1st or 2nd round control <u>up the line</u> (below game)
- If we missing control of any suit, we sign off at game

Once we can't show controls any more, we can use Key Card Blackwood to identify how many key cards we have in order to:

decide to bid slam or sign off at 5 level?
