

## Ogust – Game assessment after partner opens weak-two

After a weak-two opening by partner, if responder is interested in game, **2NT by responder** asks for strength and quality of opener's hand. Responses are:

- 3♣ shows a "minimal" hand with a "poor" suit
- 3♦ shows a "minimal" hand with a "good" suit
- 3♥ shows a "maximal" hand with a "poor" suit
- 3♠ shows a "maximal" hand with a "good" suit
- 3NT shows a "solid" suit (that is, AKQ of the long suit)

After knowing the quality of opener's hand, responder decide on the final contract.

Definitions:

- **"minimal" hand** = 6-7 high card points
- **"good" suits** = two of the top three or three of the top five cards
